- Willis Carrier

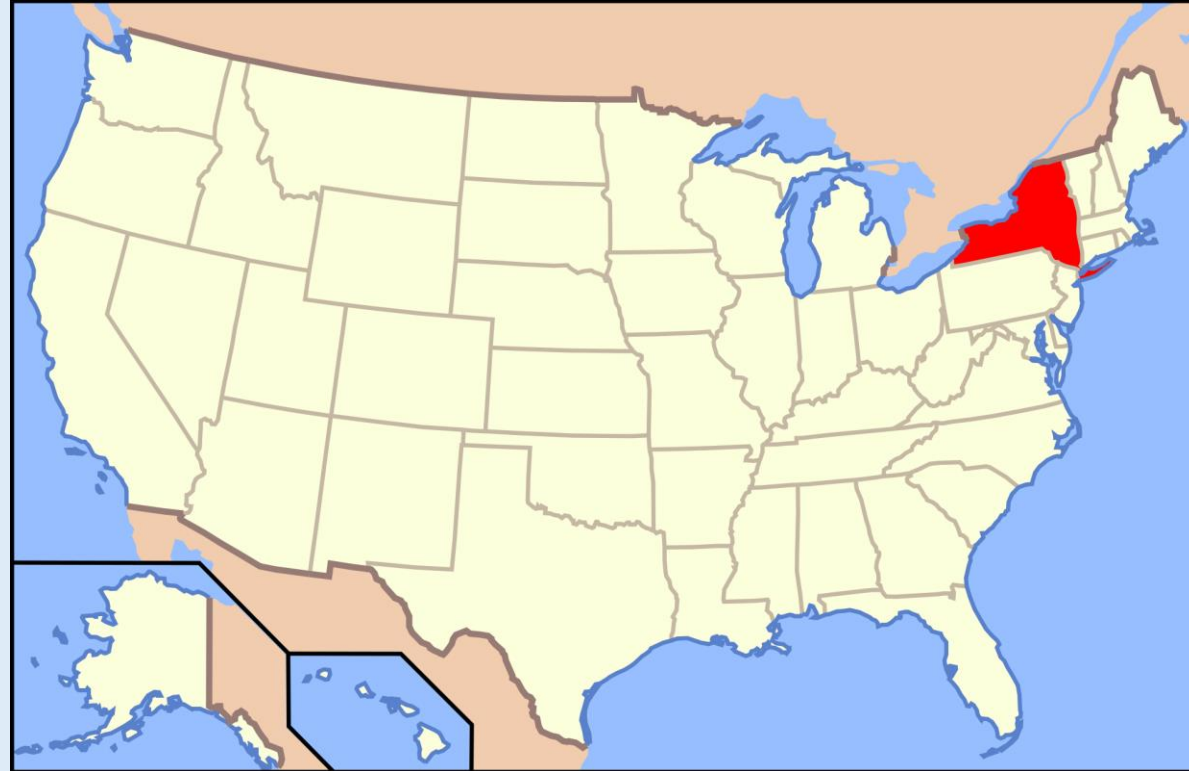


When

- 1881-1902
- 1881: President James Garfield used a device involving air blown through cotton sheets doused in ice water
- 1900's: Nikola Tesla makes oscillating fans possible
- 1902: Willis Carrier invented the first modern air-conditioning system

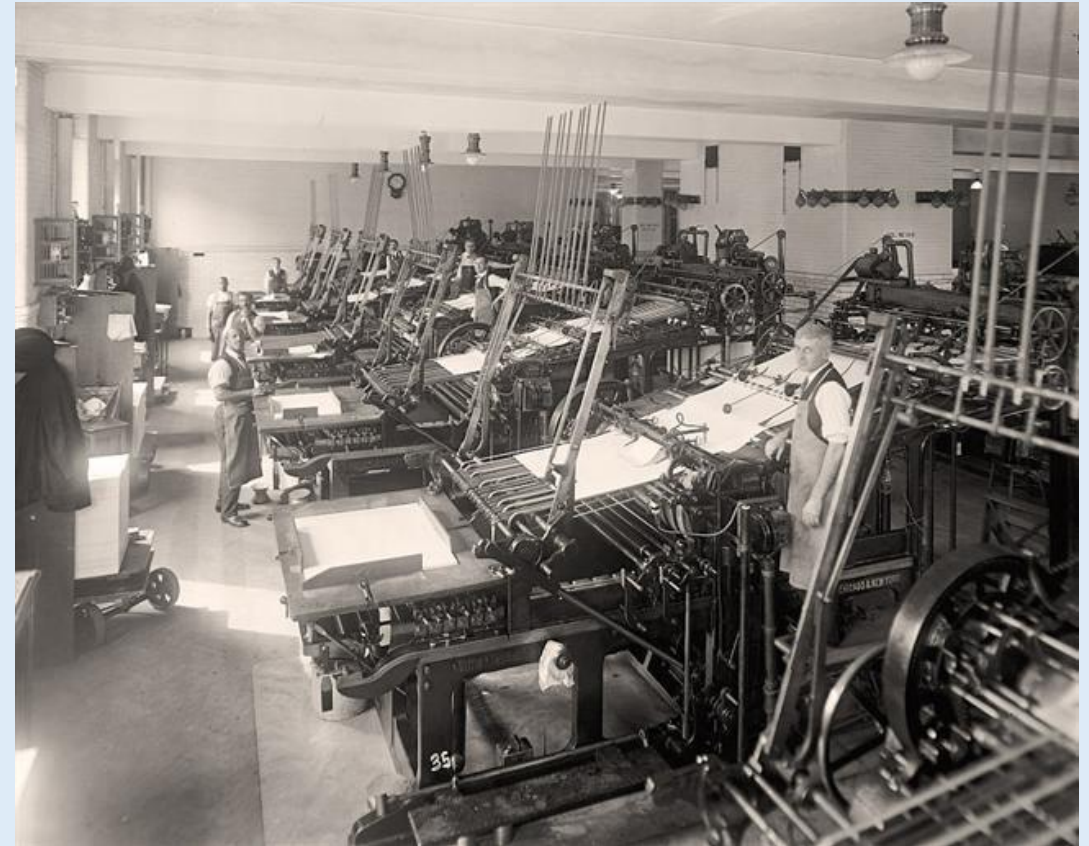
Where

- United States

Why

- The mechanical unit was not aimed at human comfort
- Control humidity in the printing plant where he worked



How

- Sent air through water-cooled coils
- Utilized a central compressor to reduce size
